KS₂ Assessment in 2018

Statutory assessment

- KS2 national curriculum tests with outcomes in the form of scaled scores.
- Teacher assessment at KS2 using the interim framework for teacher assessment.

Formative classroom assessment

- Determined by schools in line with their curriculum.

Teacher Assessment

Children develop at different times and in individual ways, but at the end of Year 6 the DfE guidelines and codes for English and maths are as follows:-

WORKING TOWARDS the 'Nationally Expected Standard' for a pupil at the end of Year 6 - WTS (Writing only)

HAS NOT MET the 'Nationally Expected Standard' for a pupil at the end of Year 6 - HNM (Reading, Maths and Science)

WORKING AT the 'Nationally Expected Standard' for a pupil at the end of Year 6 - EXS (All subjects)

WORKING AT GREATER DEPTH within the 'Nationally Expected Standard' for a pupil at the end of Year 6 - GDS (Writing only)

SCALED SCORES

- Tests at the end of KS2 will report in scaled scores.
- The 'expected standard' will always be set at 100.
- Raw scores in the test will be converted to scaled scores.
- The 'raw score' that equates to 100 might be different each year.
- Pupils who score 100 or more will have met the 'expected standard' - AS
- Pupils who score below 100 will not have met the 'expected standard' - NS
- The range is from 85 120
- In 2017 a 'High Scaled Score' was a 110
